The petitioner, Lynn Victor Seeley, whose race or color is white, being a resident of the State of Oregon, living at Route 1 Street, City of Independence, and having filed a petition for the registration of his birth, and having served a copy thereof upon the district attorney of this county, and more than five days having elapsed since the service and filing of said petition,

And the court having held a hearing upon said petition and being satisfied that the facts stated therein are supported by substantial evidence, hereby finds that petitioner was born at Independence, in the County of Polk, State of Oregon, on the 30 day of April, in the year 1892;

That petitioner's original name was [First] [Middle] [Last name]; that on the [Month] [Year], said name was changed to [Month] [Year], by [Marriage, adoption, own action, court order];

That petitioner's father was Horace G. Seeley, of the City of Independence, Polk Co., State of Oregon, who was born at Elmira, New York, on the 7th day of March, 1861, and that petitioner's mother was Martinia Seeley, of the City of Independence, Polk County, State of Oregon, whose maiden name was Martinia Welch, and who was born at Iowa, on the 7th day of January, 1866.

And the court further finds that petitioner is entitled to a decree of this court requiring the registration of the birth of said petitioner by the State Registrar of Vital Statistics.

IT IS, THEREFORE, hereby ordered and decreed that the birth of said petitioner be registered by the State Registrar of Vital Statistics.
